1. Assembled Hull Dimensions D.12.2

Old:

Lifelines of wire not less than 3mm (plus approx. 3mm coating of plastic) shall be attached at the pulpit and shall pass through the stanchions.

New:

Lifelines of wire not less than \varnothing 3 mm (plus approx. 3mm coating of plastic) or lines of HMPE (Dyneema, Spectra) not less than \varnothing 4 mm shall be attached at the pulpit and shall pass through the stanchions.

Old:

Top width with forestay profilemax. 60 mm

Top width without forestay profilemax. 80 mm

New:

Top width with forestay profile.....max. 70 mm

Top width without forestay profilemax. 90 mm

Old:

New:
